Kent Highways advise that they have cleansed all the drains in New Road Hill and the addition of kerbs at the entrance of Pattison Farm Close has resolved the issue.

With regard to Giggers Green Road further CCTV work is to be undertaken and reshaping of the carriageway is required the Drainage Officer is scheduled to revisit the site and make the necessary orders for the works to be undertaken.
